He was previously Assistant Headteacher at Lampton School, where his department won the Inclusion Award at the National Business Education Awards, the same year the school received its third consecutive Outstanding judgement. David was awarded an OBE for services to Special Educational Needs and Disability in the 2016 New Year's Honours list.
