# CAPH Conference - March 17th, 2023 - Trans Atlantic Cognitively

## **Dr Laura Jana**

We have secured Omaha, Nebraska based paediatrician, educator, health communicator and award-winning author, Dr. Laura Jana to join, in person, our March CAPH conference.

Dr Laura finds connections across disciplines and crystallises big ideas into far-reaching, real world applications, with a focus on social impact.

As a translator of ideas and facilitator of dialogue, she is on a mission to change the parenting paradigm and the public conversation about the skills needed for success in the 21st Century. She will be sharing her QI Skills with us.

Dr Laura has been working with Nanstallon School, Bodmin, where they have been implementing her QI Skills model as their agreed learning language. The QI Skills are the essential non-cognitive skills and represent a new set of skills deemed absolutely necessary for success in today's rapidly changing world. It encompasses the concepts of Guy Claxton's building learning power, growth mind set, operating a school without the need for rewards and sanctions (developing intrinsic motivation)

Ben Stephenson – Headteacher Nanstallon will be joining Dr Laura at our conference to share his experience and long term strategy of putting the QI Skills into practice.

## **Clive Davies OBE**

Our afternoon session will be presented by Clive Davies OBE, he is one of the founder Directors of [Focus Education](#), working with school both nationally and internationally. He draws on a vast experience, including work as a Headteacher, Ofsted inspector, Local Authority adviser, trainer and consultant. He was awarded an OBE for his services to education in 2009.

He has been working to support schools in Cornwall including Furlanesend, and comes highly recommended.

The session looks at the very recent research available to us and considers how schools are using this to improve the quality of education being provided in schools. It is intended to be a very practical session taking account of the theory, not one that provides the theory alone.

He will be working with you to ensure that important lessons from research are implemented in day-to-day practice. The session will inspire you to delve deeply into the teaching, learning and assessment culture at your school or academy. It will help you take stock, look at the bigger picture and guide you to make decisions about your practice and your pupils' learning and retention of knowledge.
